DID THEY ACHIEVE ANY OF THEIR AIMS, IN WHAT WAYS, AND WHAT WAS THE LEGACY OF THEIR SUCCESSES AND FAILURES?**

**THE FIRST SYMPOSIUM IN OXFORD LAST YEAR HIGHLIGHTED A NUMBER OF FURTHER THEMES THAT SHOULD BE INVESTIGATED, IN ADDITION TO MANY OTHER ESTABLISHED AND EMERGING SCHOLARS WHOSE RESEARCH IS ESSENTIAL TO ENHANCING OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THIS CRUCIAL ERA OF HISTORY, ESPECIALLY FOR ANATOLIA AND THE BALKANS. ECONOMIC, ECCLESIASTICAL, FOREIGN AND SOCIAL HISTORY TAKE CENTRE STAGE IN THE SESSIONS WE HAVE ORGANIZED HERE.**

**THIS SECOND SYMPOSIUM, HELD IN THE MOST APPROPRIATE LOCATION OF ISTANBUL ITSELF, WILL THEREFORE BRING TOGETHER THE RESEARCH AND PEOPLE IN ORDER THAT THE PROPOSED HANDBOOK OF RESEARCH ON THE KOMNENIAN DYNASTY CAN COALESCE.
